New Reimbursement Procedure for GY2

Starting Q1 of Grant Year 2, IHE partners will be required to include a GU budget spend report in their reimbursement packet each quarter and submit an invoice that matches their total spending for that quarter. This change will be reflected in the language of your forthcoming GY2 contract. Please note that, outside of the full packet in Q2, no other backup documentation will be required in the reimbursement packet. This new bill-for-what-you-spend procedure will increase clarity and transparency in IHE reimbursements while avoiding the potential of overbilling.

App State staff will be reaching out to program coordinators and finance staff to review the procedure and field any questions.
