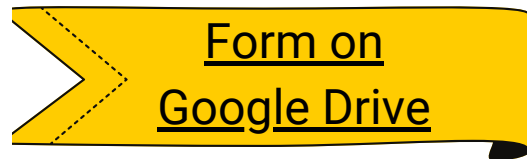

Data Entry Confidentiality Form

The processes of data collection and reporting inherently involve access to the personally identifiable information of our students; therefore, any staff with access to the Lyceum database must sign a data confidentiality agreement.
