Summer Data Entry in Lyceum

Service data entry should be completed in Lyceum by June 30th for services that took place on or before June 15. To close out the 2016-2017 academic year and similar to what we did last year, please ensure that all student, professional, and parent services that occurred on or before June 15 are entered into Lyceum by June 30th.

What does this mean for services that occur after June 15? All rosters for services that occur after June 15 will need to be held until the 2017-2018 demographic data are loaded into the system. This usually takes place in the August or September time frame.

Also, and unlike last year, Lyceum will remain available during the summer in case you need to look up information or make use of the reports. You just won't be able to enter any additional services that have taken place after June 15.

EPPP Application Deadline Extended

By popular demand, we have extended the EPPP deadline to June 30, 2017.

A few important things to note:

- Please make sure applications are submitted by the candidate to the EPPP email address (EPPP@ncappstate.edu)
Any approved applicants that submitted by the May 31 deadline were sent an acceptance notification on June 14, 2017 and must respond with a confirmation of their participation by August 1, 2017.
Applicants that apply in the month of June can expect to receive acceptance notifications sometime between July 1-15, 2017 and will need to confirm their participation by August 1, 2017.
If your district/institution/etc. does not intend to submit any applicants this year, please inform Corinne ASAP (amthnc3@ncappstate.edu).
Remember to include the travel costs in your GY04 work plans for each participant from your district.

Tutor.com Sponsorship of School Events

Please note that Tutor.com/The Princeton Review is willing to sponsor large school events. This has typically been most successful at large open house or orientation events at the start of the school year. In the first round review of district work plans, there were many noted events like this.
