EPPP Application Deadline Extended

To all of you who have helped to ensure your applicants have submitted materials by the May 31 deadline, thank you! We have heard from some of you that you need more time to complete the application process and submit materials for consideration.

By popular demand, we have extended the deadline to June 30, 2017.

A few important things to note:

- Please make sure applications are submitted by the candidate to the EPPP email address (EPPFNS@indiana.gov)
Any approved applicants that submitted by the May 31 deadline will be sent approval/acceptance notifications by June 15 as originally published.
Applicants that apply in the month of June can expect to receive acceptance notifications sometime between July 1-15, 2017.
If your district/institution/etc. does not intend to submit any applicants this year, please inform Corinne ASAP (cmrnc3@epstate.edu).

GEAR UP Coordinator Staff Changes

As many of you may know, two of our GEAR UP District Coordinators will be moving away this summer and leaving their positions in Henry and Graham counties. Kristen Robinson will be transitioning out of her position on June 15, 2017, and Elle King's last day is June 30, 2017. Both counties have worked hard to develop a transition plan for a new coordinator and once those details are finalized, we will be sure to share them with you.

Summer Services Eligibility

The turn of GY13 into GY14 brings a new situation as we begin serving students, parents, and teachers through the summer months. Summer is a tricky time because transition is in full swing as students begin rising to the next grade level, and this is the first time that we have to STOP serving certain grade levels. To ensure you are continuing to serve the appropriate groups, we wanted to clarify services eligibility for this summer.

- Teachers who teach only 6th grade students will no longer be eligible for summer 2017 professional development services.
Students who are rising 7th, 8th, 9th, and 10th are the only students eligible for summer 2017 student services (no more rising 6th graders).
Purchases made by school districts for 6th grade classrooms/teachers/etc. are no longer allowable. These materials, if purchased, would not be serving GEAR UP cohort students when students return to the classroom in Fall 2017, therefore, these purchases would be unallowable.
